Alliance Fiber Optic Products Inc. (AFOP) has been pursuing compliance with European Union requirements – EU Directive 2002/95/EC, “Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)”.

Our Quality Assurance (QA) team is formally engaged in the process of addressing RoHS for all our products. We are targeting a continued on-going RoHS compliance where any of the restricted substances will be eliminated, or reduced to acceptable threshold levels.

Lead (pb) – 1000 ppm

Mercury (Hg) – 1000 ppm

Cadmium (Cd) – 100 ppm

Hexavalent Chromium (Cr) – 1000 ppm

Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) – 1000 ppm

Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE) – 1000 ppm

AFOP will continue to implement testing procedures for raw materials and finished products to ensure continued compliance with these mandates, via supplier controls and in-house process management.

We will continue to work with the EU to monitor any additional requirements that may develop to ensure AFOP remains a RoHS compliant manufacturer. We look forward to working with our customers to support their compliance needs.
